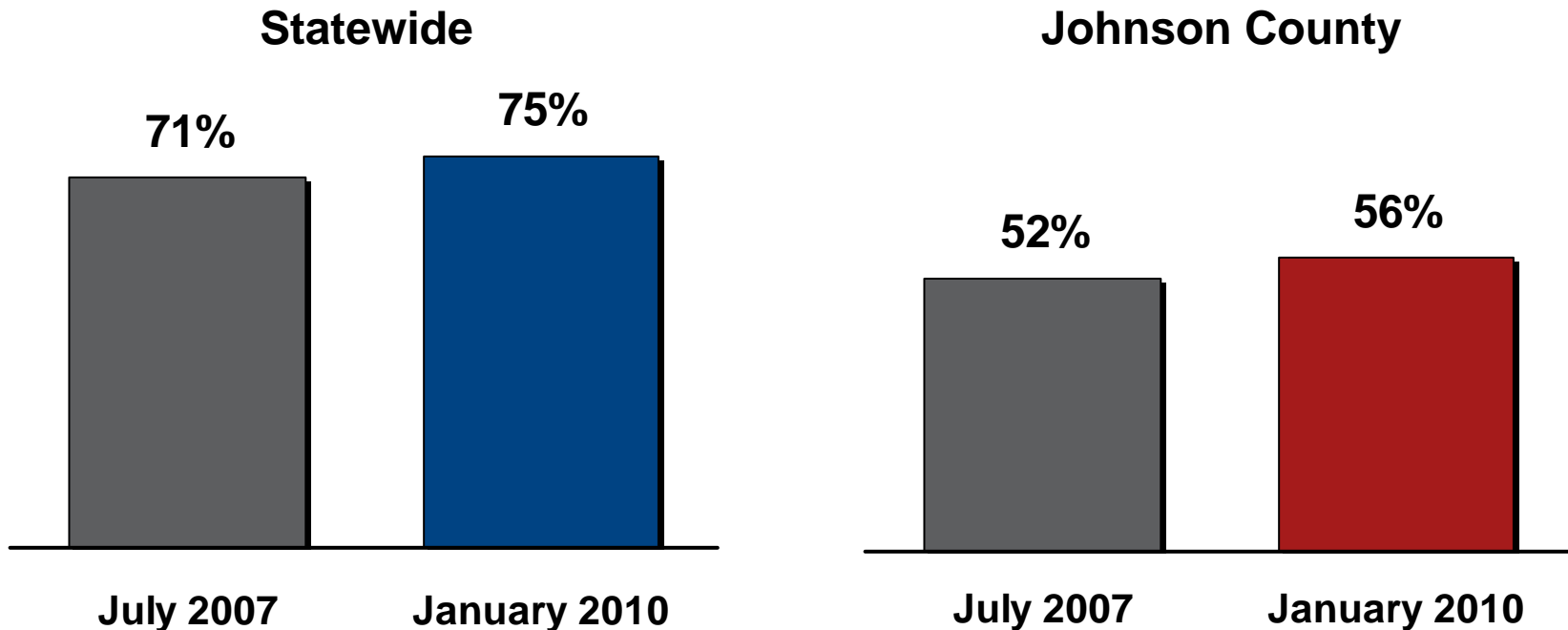

Households with a home computer



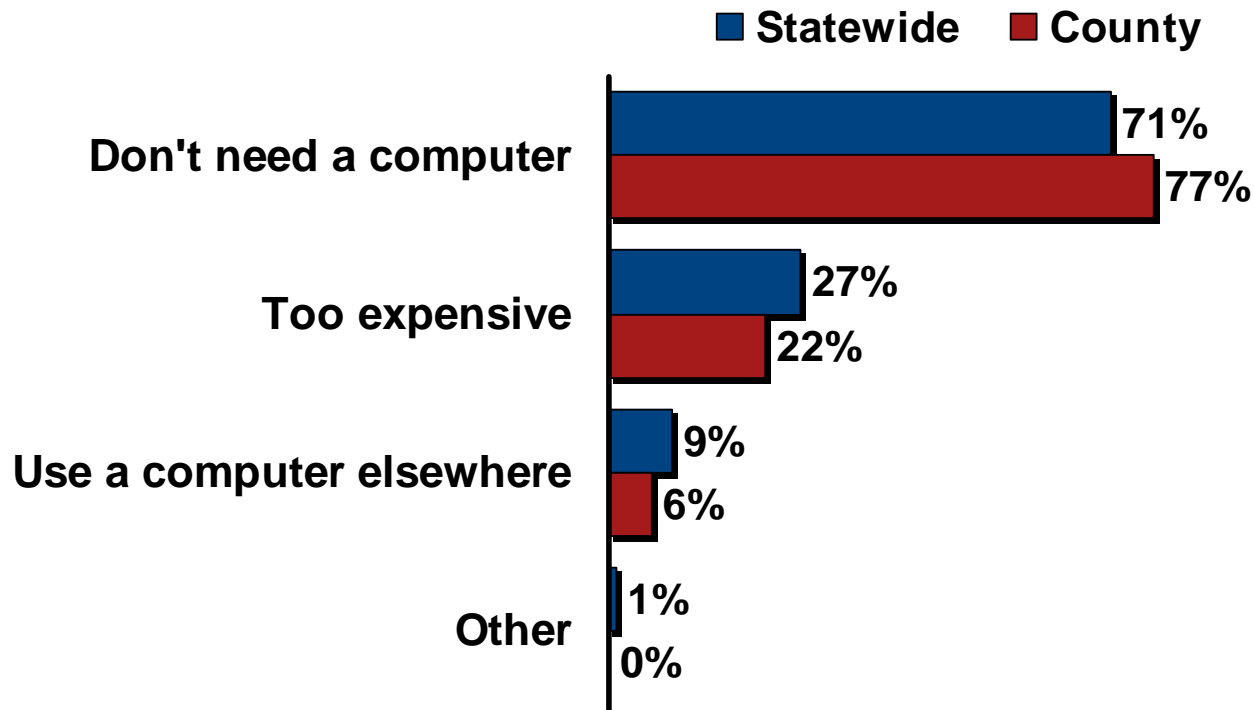
Q: Does your household have a computer?

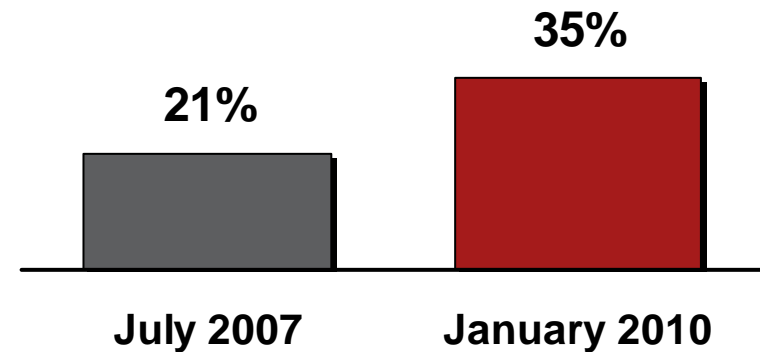
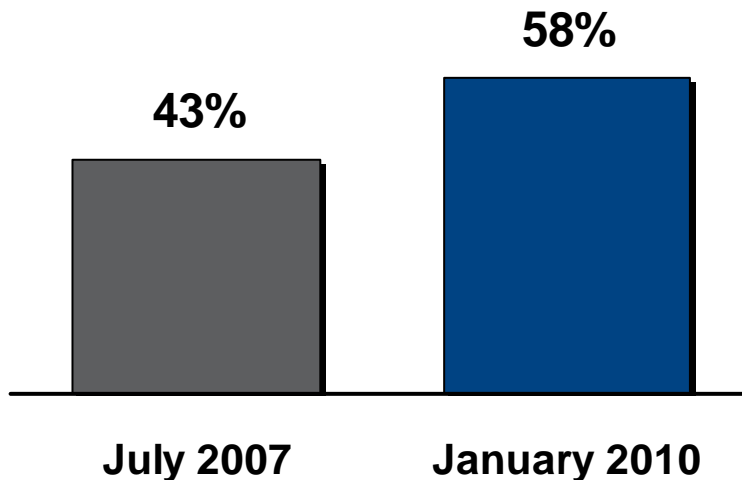


Broadband Adoption in Johnson County

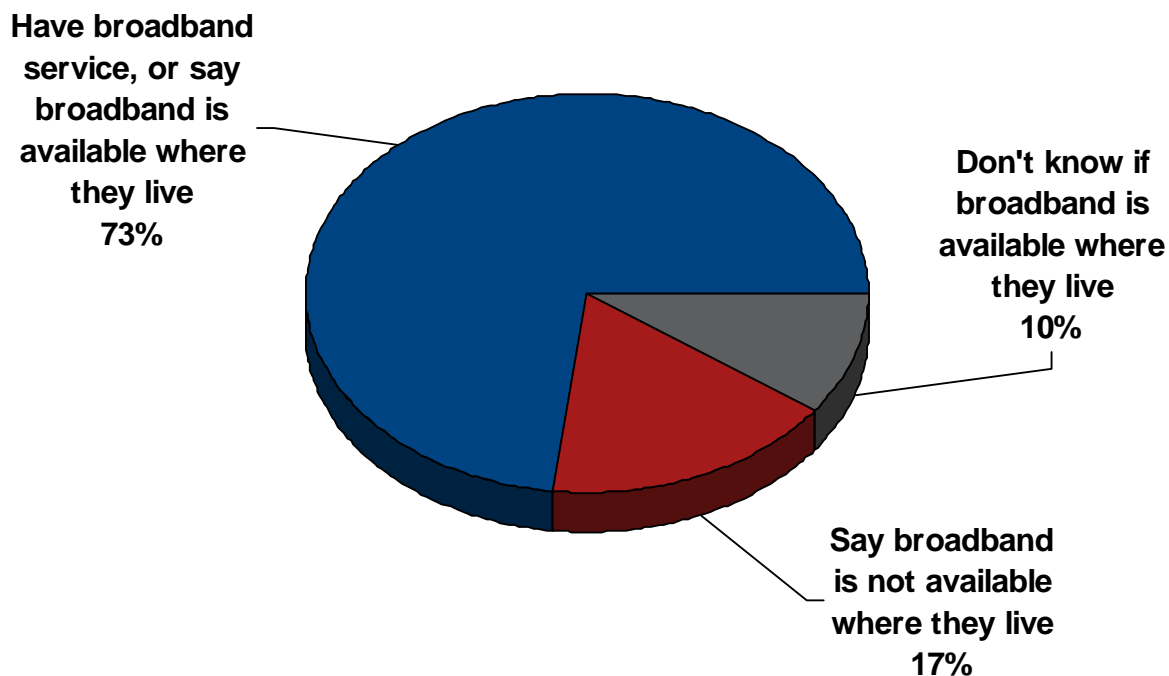

Awareness of broadband availability in Johnson County



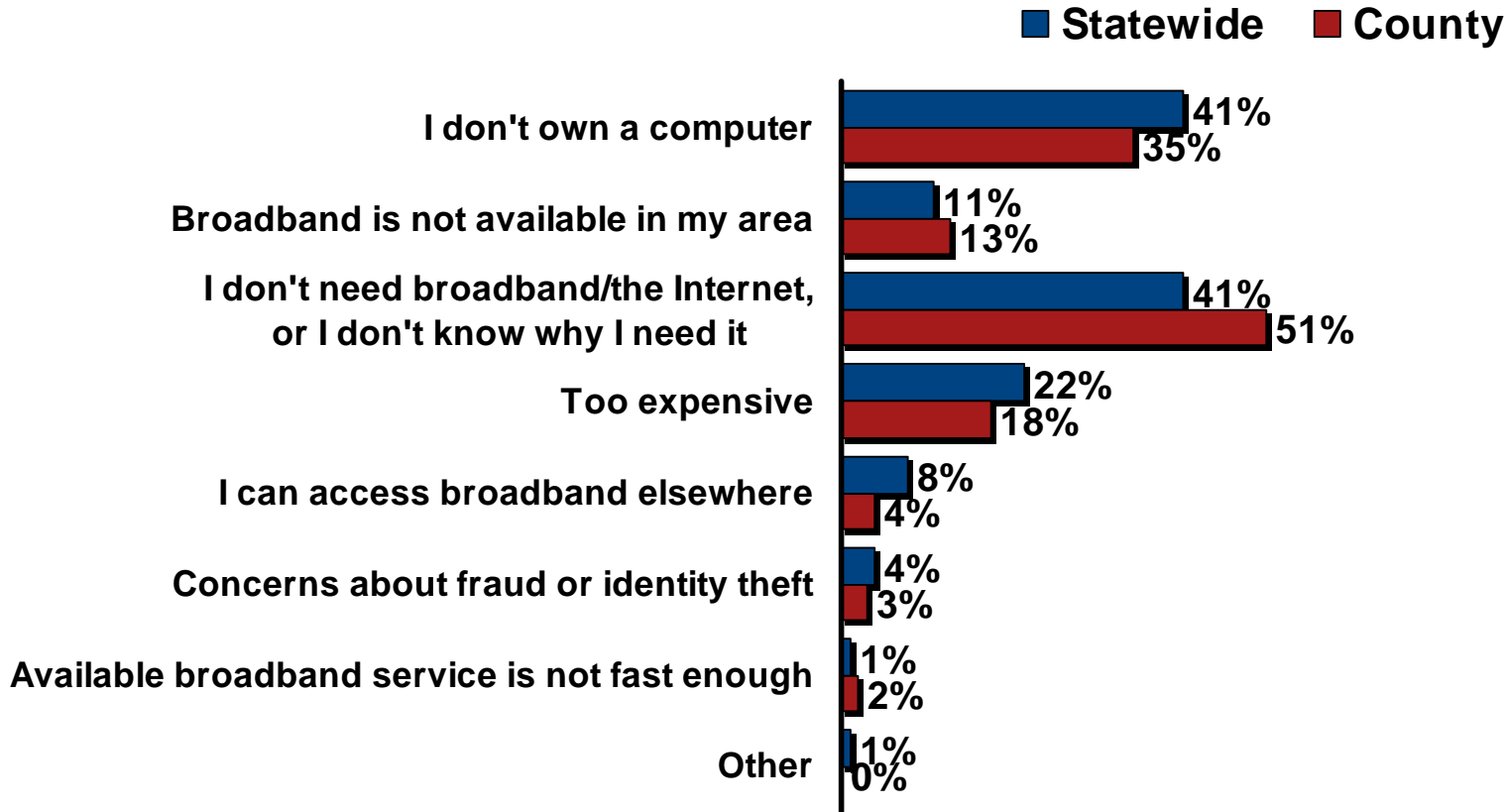
Q: To the best of your knowledge, is broadband or high-speed Internet service available in the area where you live?

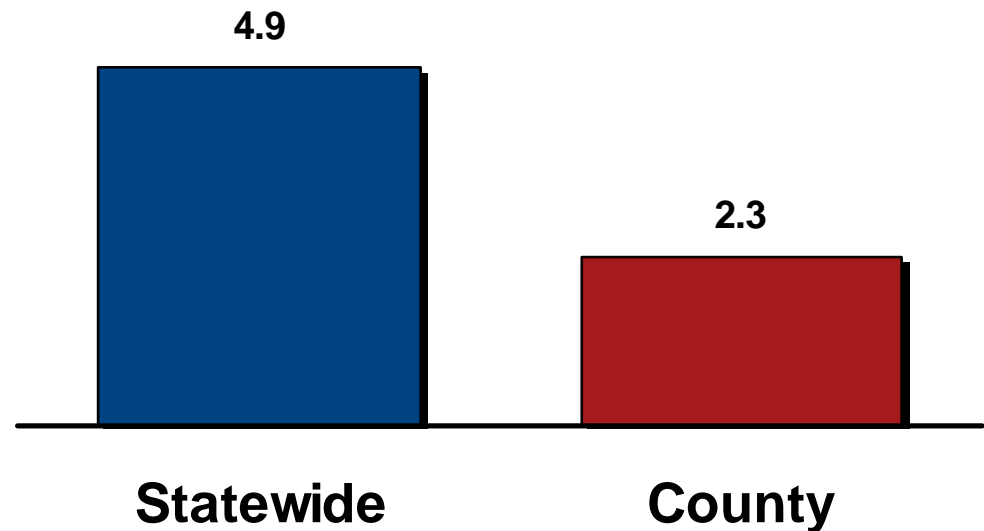


Broadband Download Speeds

Broadband subscribers who know their download speeds reported an average speed of 4.9 Mbps.

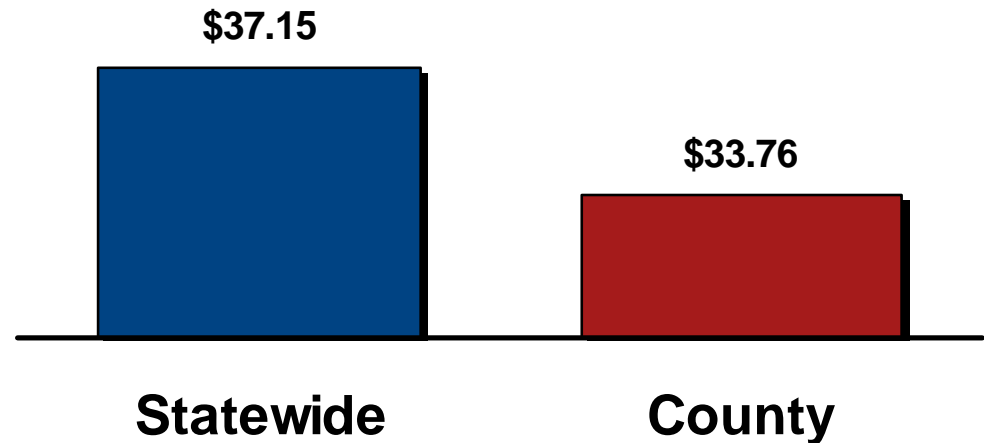

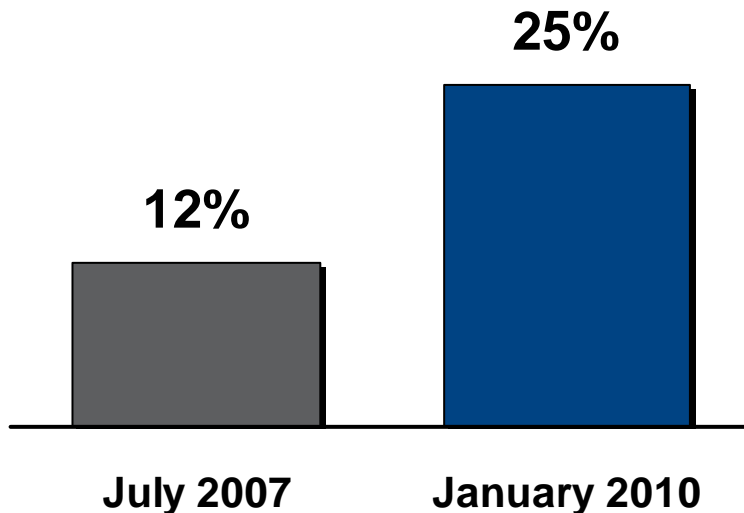

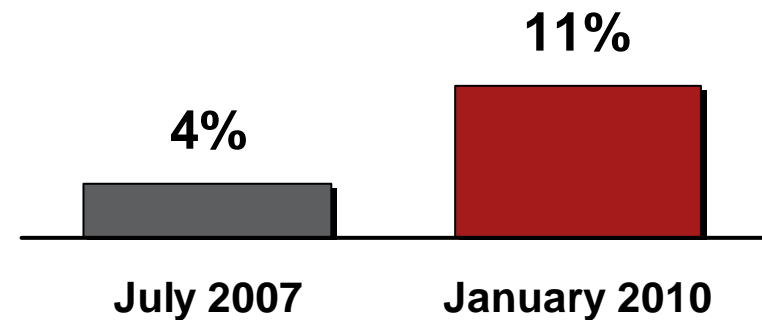
Trends in Wi-Fi Zone ("Hot Spot") Usage

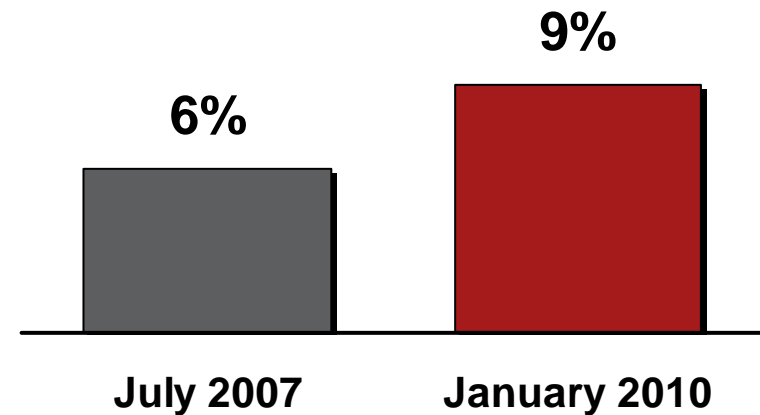
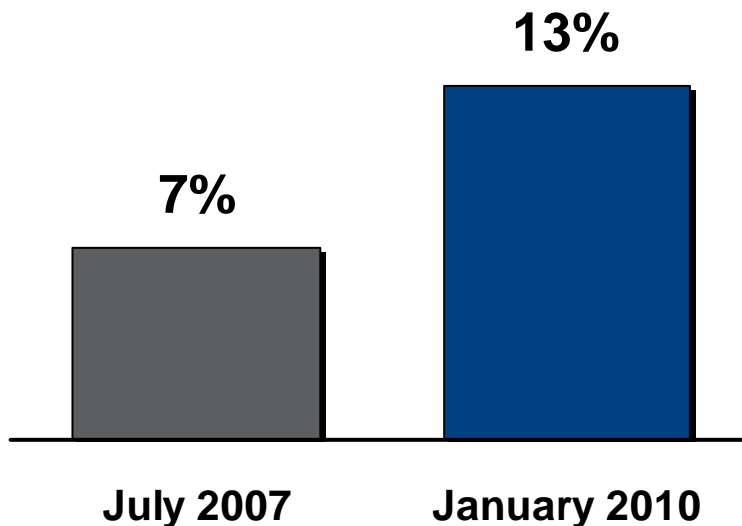


Teleworking Trends Among Residents

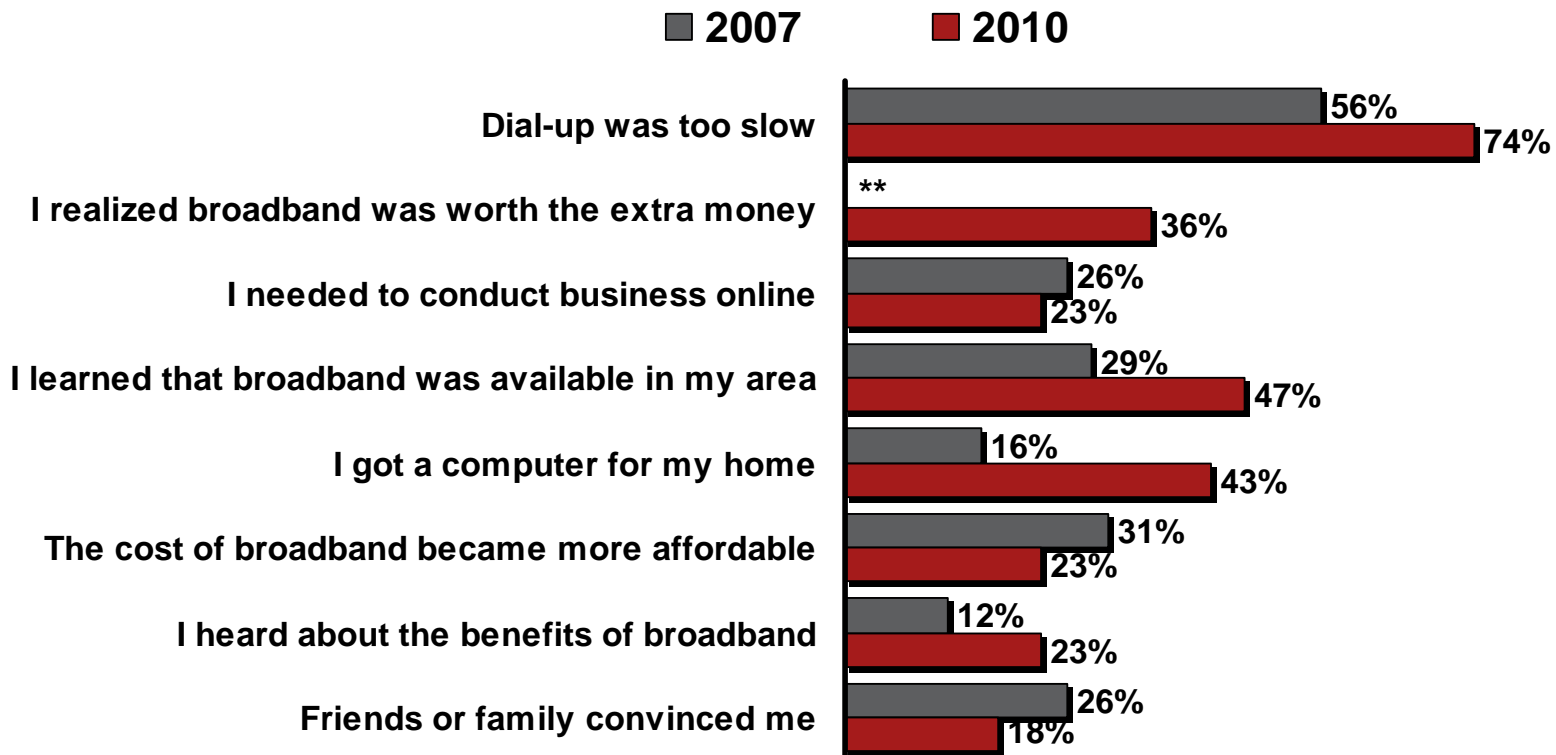

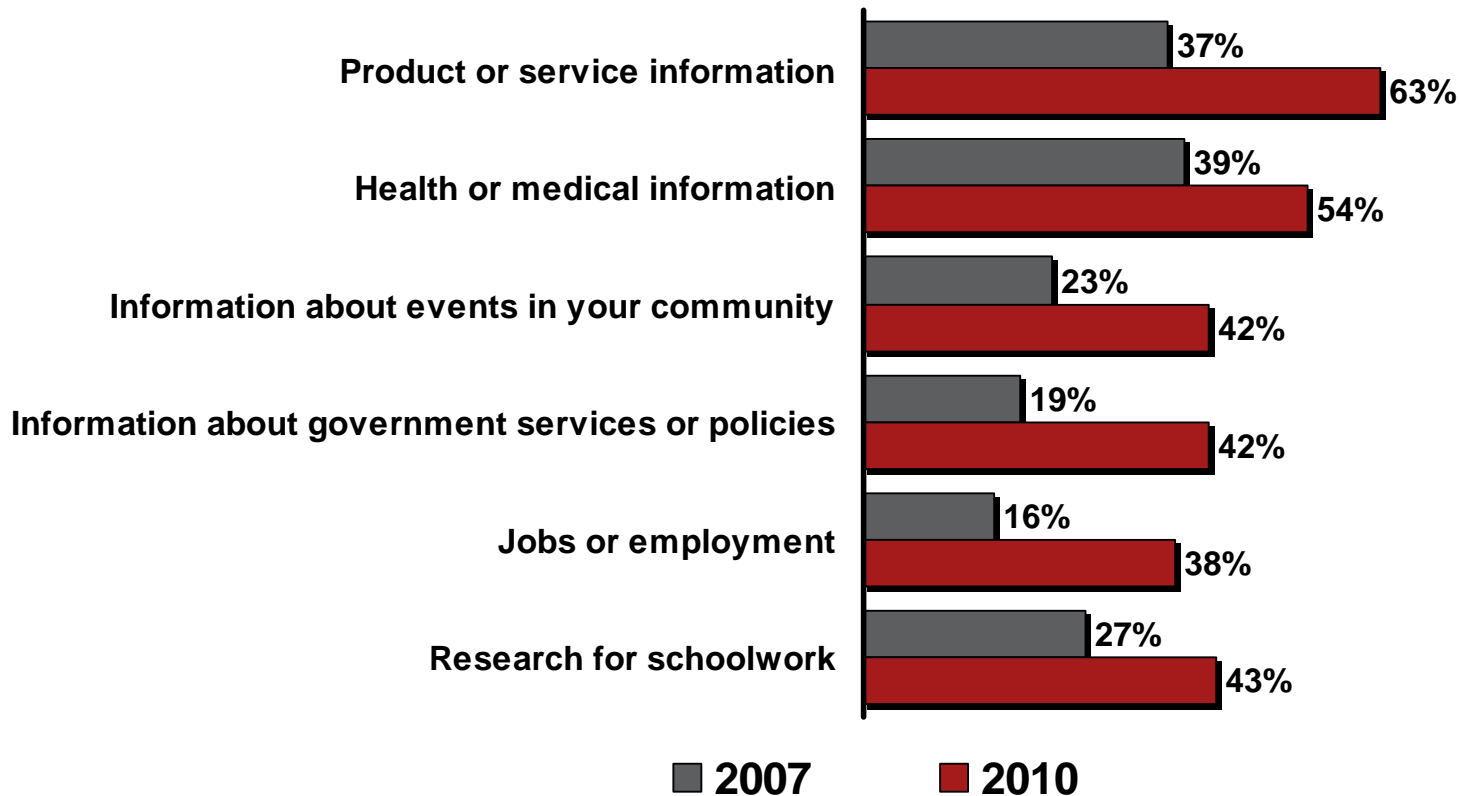


Trends in Online Activities Among Tennessee Internet Users

Percent of Johnson County Internet users who have searched for the following types of information



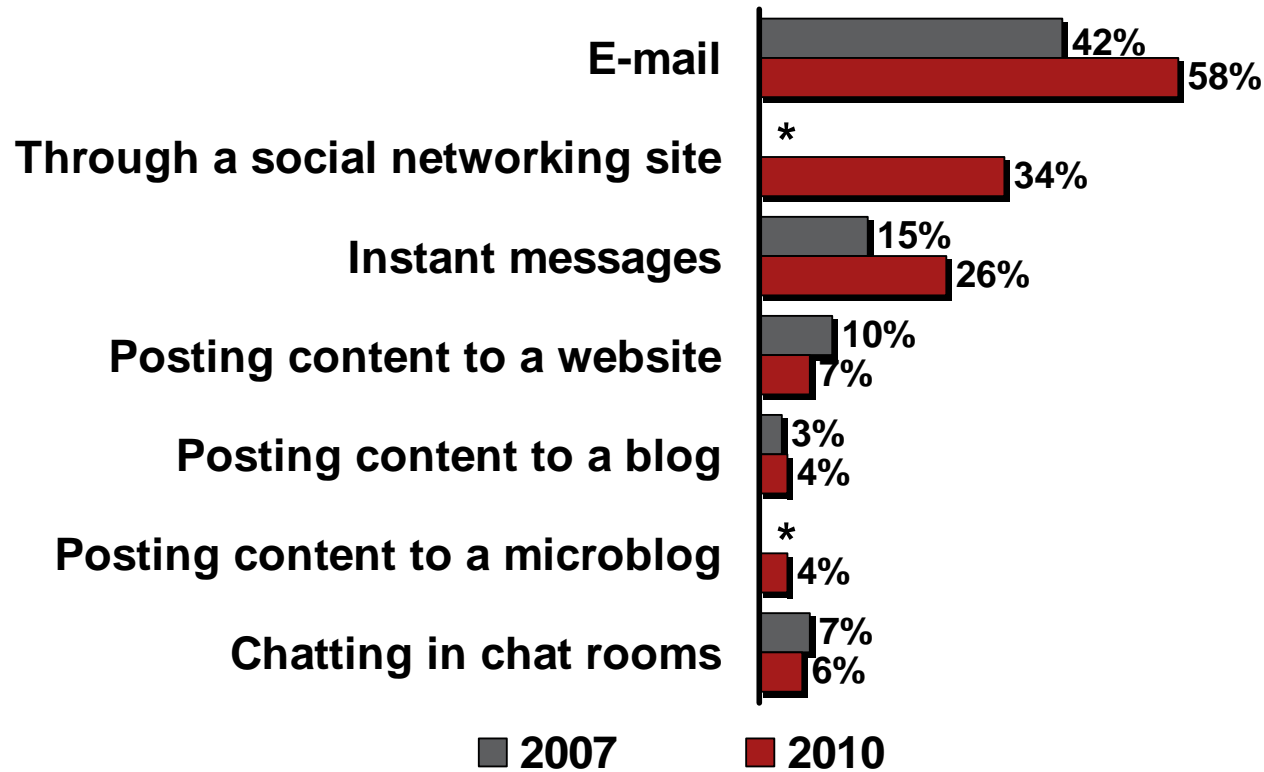

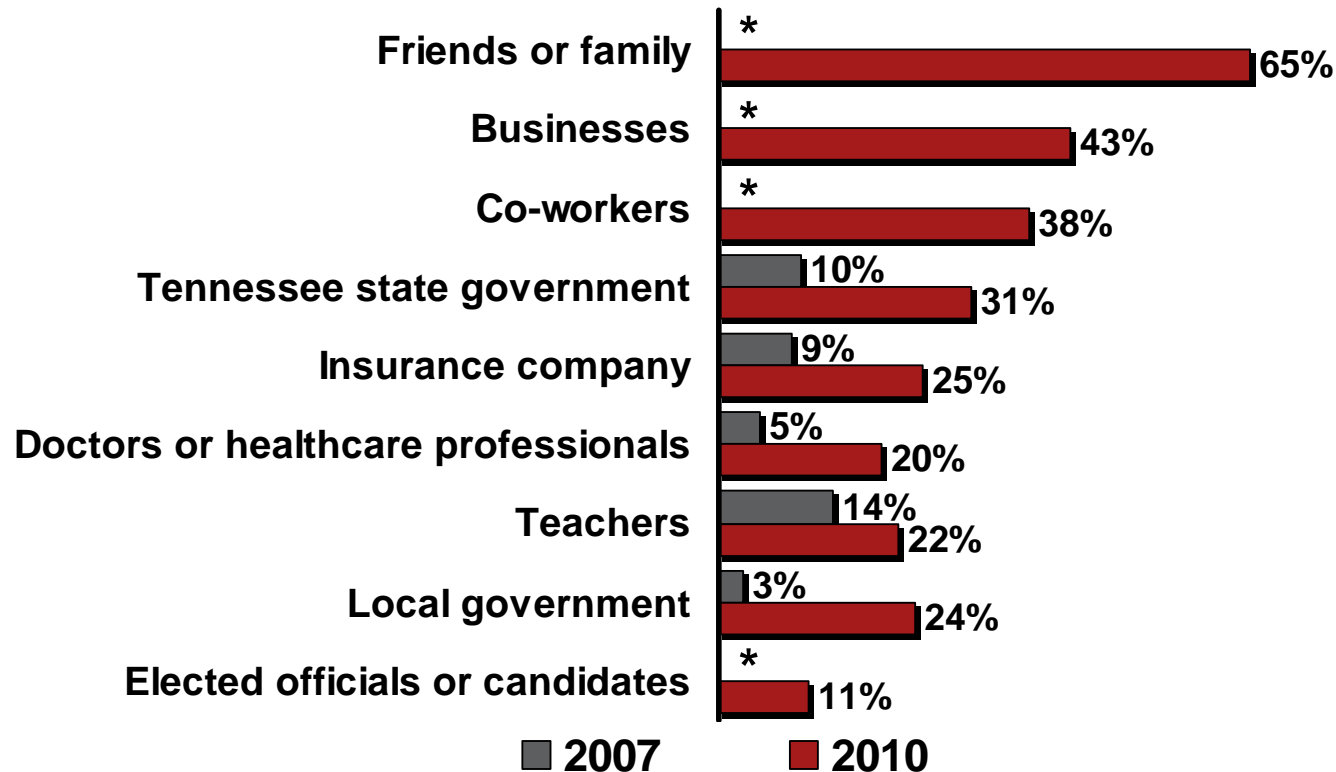

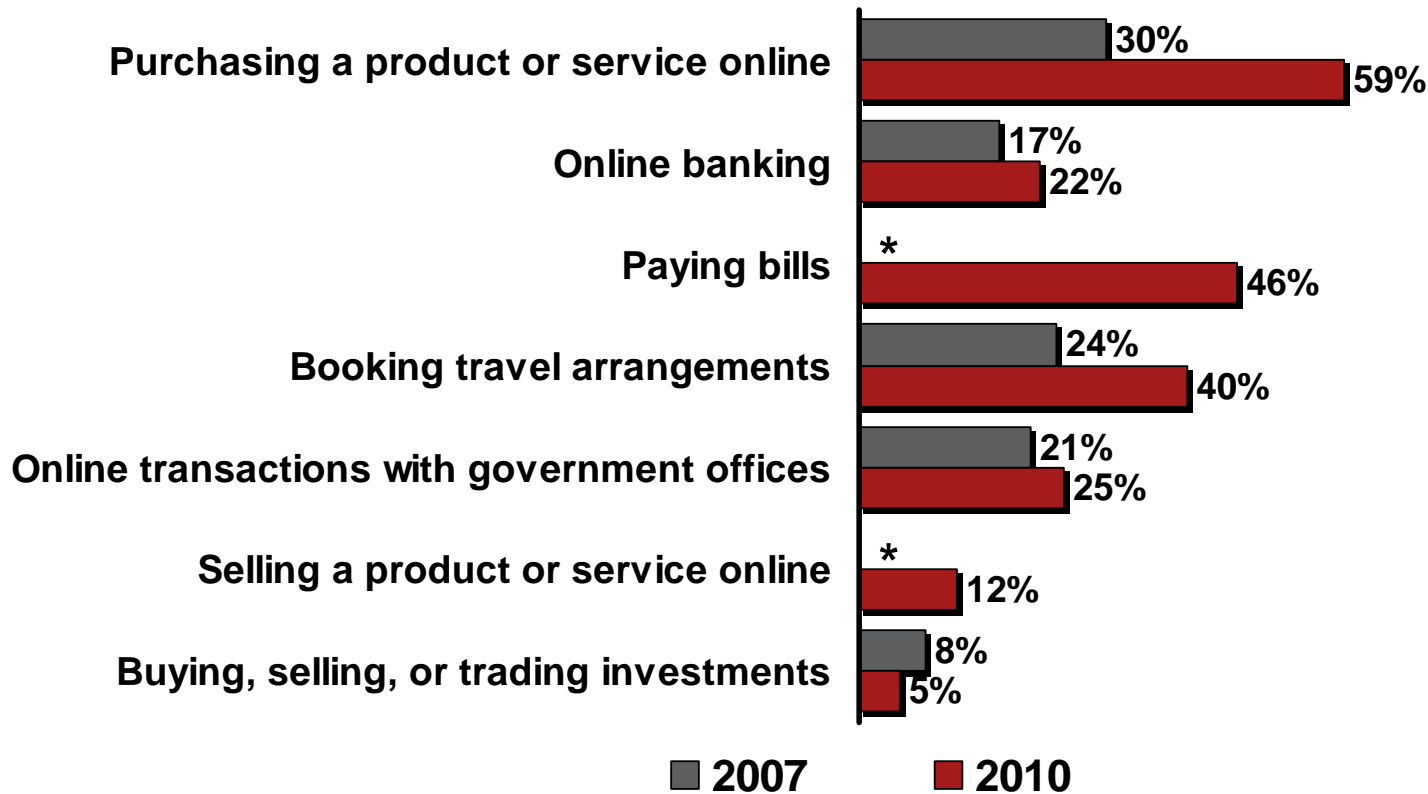

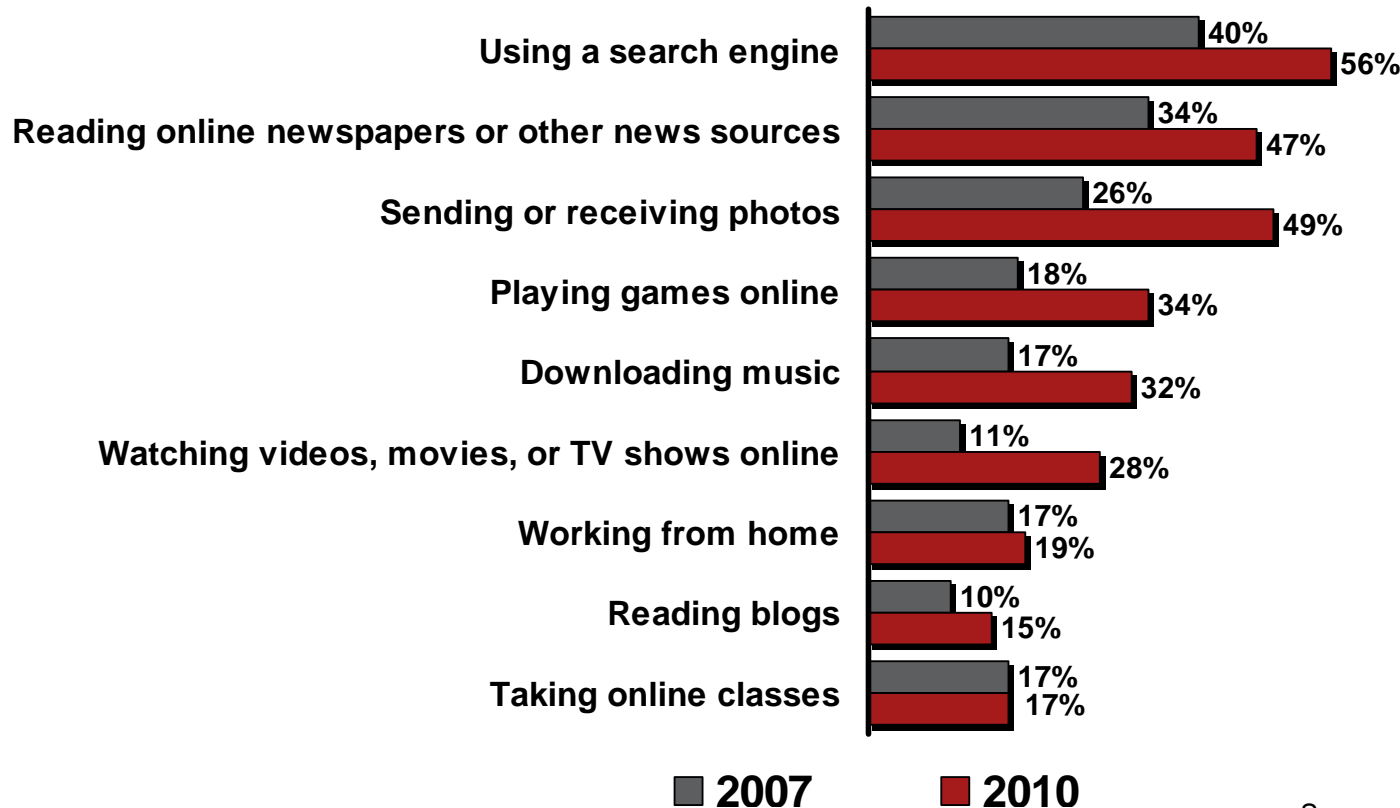
