Nashville-based Connected Tennessee's Computers 4 Kids program has donated 133 new Dell computers to families in Tipton and Lauderdale counties.

Connected Tennessee is a public-private group that partners with technology-based businesses, universities and the state government to accelerate technology in Tennessee. The Computers 4 Kids program provides computers to disadvantaged children throughout the state. The program's goal is to provide at least 1,000 computers per year for the next three years.

The distribution was handled in conjunction with the Department of Human Services, which helps targeted families in its Families First Program.
